Misc:

Seniors attending UAFS – You should have received an email and postcard telling you to log in to your MyUAFS account to register for your (NSO) day New Student Orientation – If you have not already registered, you need to do so ASAP.

Mrs. Wisdom has given a list of seniors who are eligible for the AR Academic Challenge Scholarship to Mrs. Rachuy and Mrs. Potts. Look at the list and make sure you have completed all the requirements to be "eligible". If the list shows you are "eligibility pending", then log into your account to see what you are missing. The main reason for a student to show up as pending would be you and your guardian not filing the FAFSA. Or, if you do not have an ACT score of 19, you need to take the Accuplacer ASAP.
