Scholarships:

Misc:

Look at the list and make sure you have completed all the requirements to be "eligible". If the list shows you are "eligibility pending", then log into your account to see what you are missing. The main reason for a student to show up as pending would be you and your guardian not filing the FAFSA. Or, if you do not have an ACT score of 19, you need to take the Accuplacer ASAP.
