Scholarships:

Applications for the PTO Scholarship are available in Mrs. Rachuy's office. Applications are due by Friday, May 5th.

Greenhurst Nursing Scholarship applications are now available in Mrs. Rachuy's office. Applications are due by Friday, April 30th.

Native American Scholarship applications are available in Mrs. Rachuy's office. Applicants must be of documentable Native American descent from a federally recognized tribe. Applications are due by Friday, April 30th.

Any high school senior who will be graduating at the end of the 2021 school year, whose parents or guardians are members of Arkansas Valley Electric Cooperative. Students must have a high school grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale through the first semester of their senior year. Applications are available in Mrs. Rachuy's office and are due by 3:00 pm on Thursday, April 29th.
