UPCOMING EVENTS & DATES:

Scholarships:

The deadline for the Governor's Distinguished Scholarship has been extended to March 1, 2021. This will allow for the national ACT February 8 test score to be considered. Scholarships will be awarded by April 15, 2021.

The Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame awards nine \$1,000 scholarships to deserving Arkansas student-athlete high school seniors (5 male and 4 female). To apply for this scholarship, students must submit an essay no later than December 31st. The first 100 essays submitted will be considered for review, so don't delay!! See Mrs. Rachuy for more information

The Hagan Scholarship is a nationwide need-based merit scholarship worth up to \$48,000 for four years. Students must have a 3.75 GPA to apply. The deadline to apply is November 15th. See Mrs. Rachuy for more information.

The University of Arkansas priority deadline for admissions is November 15th. You must be admitted before you can complete scholarship applications. It takes at least 48 hours for the application to process.

The priority scholarship deadline for U of A is December 1st.

The UAFS priority deadline for merit and prestigious scholarships is November 15th. The UAFS foundation scholarships deadline is December 1st.

Arkansas Tech deadline for freshman academic and merit scholarships is November 15th. The university honors scholarship deadline is noon on December 1st.

The UCA priority deadline for admissions is November 15th. You must be admitted before you can complete scholarship applications.

The deadline for UCA distinguished and achievement scholarships is January 25th. The deadline for UCA foundation scholarships is January 29th.

MISC:

Every student that applies to UCA this week (Oct 26-30) can do it for FREE using the code **HOME2UCA**
