#### Scholarships:

The deadline for the Governor's Distinguished Scholarship has been extended to March 1, 2021. This will allow for the national ACT February 8 test score to be considered. Scholarships will be awarded by April 15, 2021.

The Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame awards nine \$1,000 scholarships to deserving Arkansas student-athlete high school seniors (5 male and 4 female). To apply for this scholarship, students must submit an essay no later than December 31st. The first 100 essays submitted will be considered for review, so don't delay!!
