- ◆ ESA funds are used to pay for salaries of: 2.0 FTE Paraprofessionals, 0.5 FTE Counselor, 0.65 FTE Curriculum Specialist. It is also used to purchase Chromebooks, Classroom Library books, materials for literacy, math and stem instruction, online software for math and literacy, ACT prep, tutoring, credit recovery, and parent involvement activities and materials.
- ◆ Professional Development funds are used to send staff to workshops and conferences for the purpose of increasing teacher quality in instructional areas. Some of the funds are transferred to ESA.
- ◆ ALE funds are used for the Charleston ALE Program.
