RESPONSIBILITY IS ONE OF THE CHARACTERS WE WOULD LIKE TO INSTILL IN OUR CMS STUDENTS.

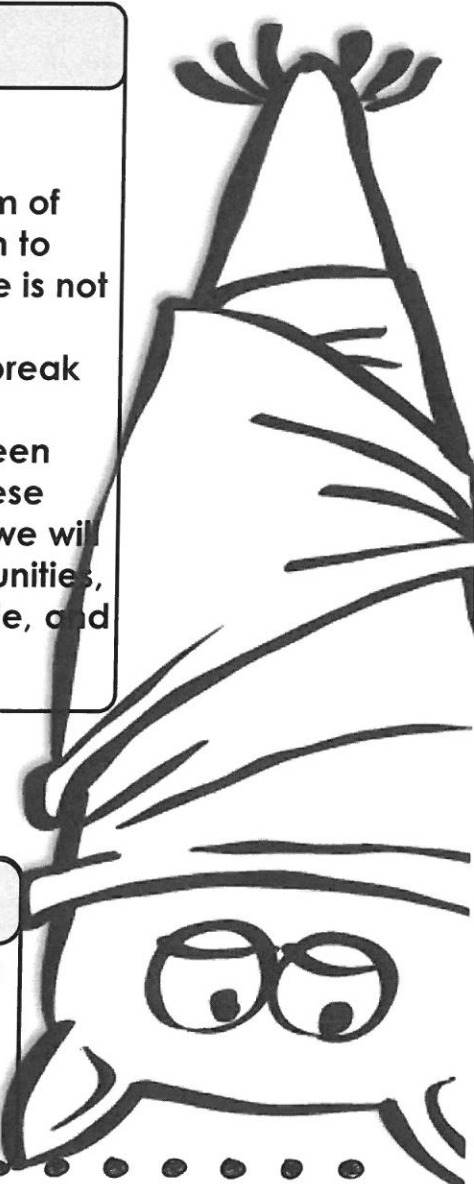
