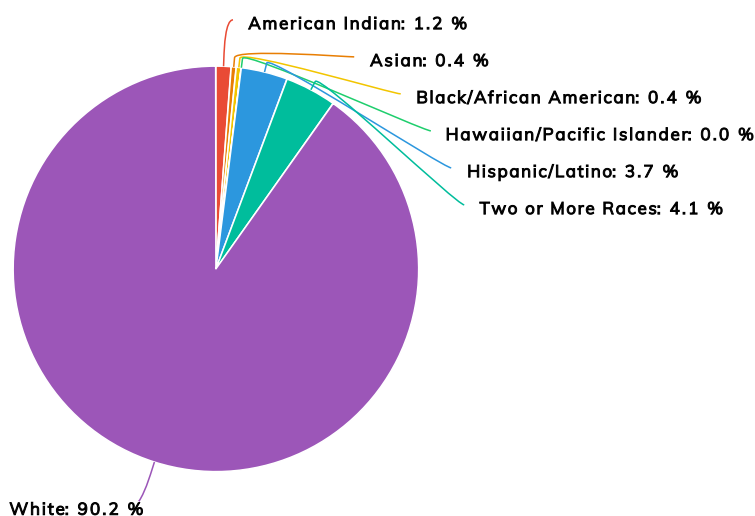

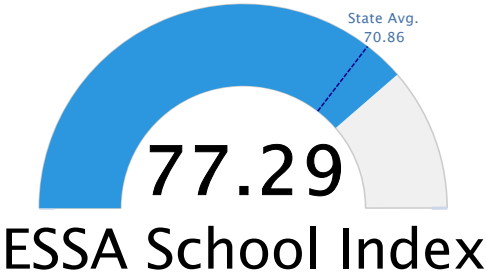

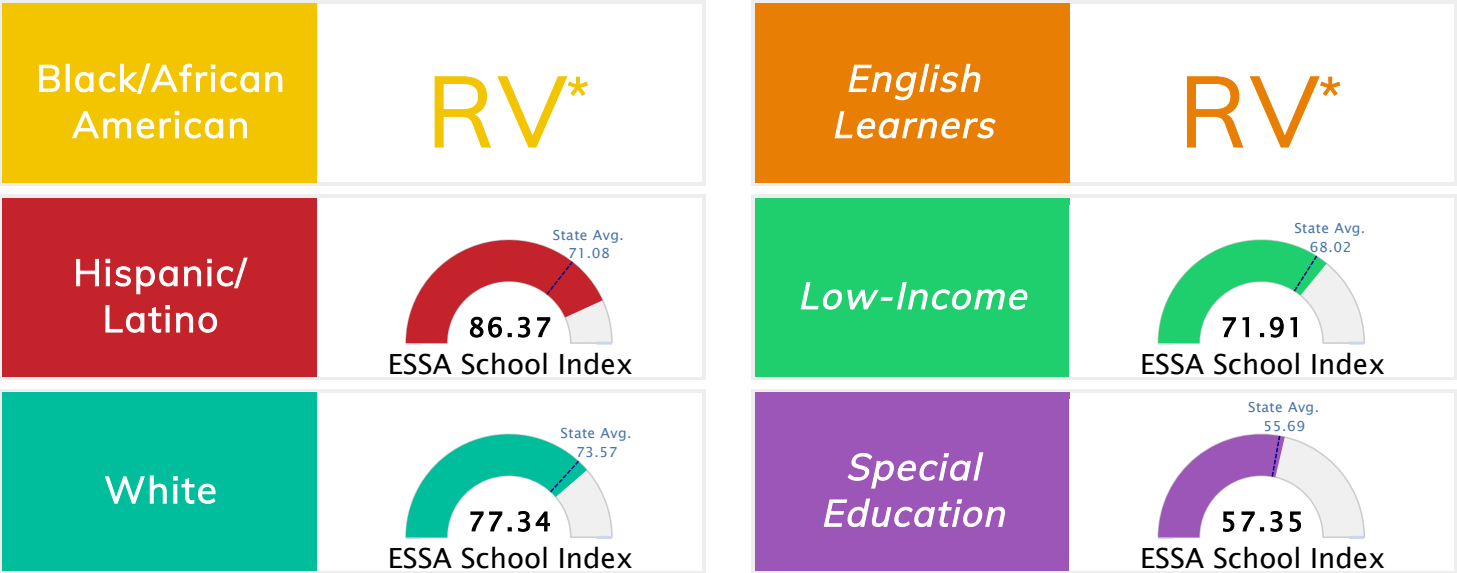
School Performance on the ESSA School Index Score (Federal Accountability)

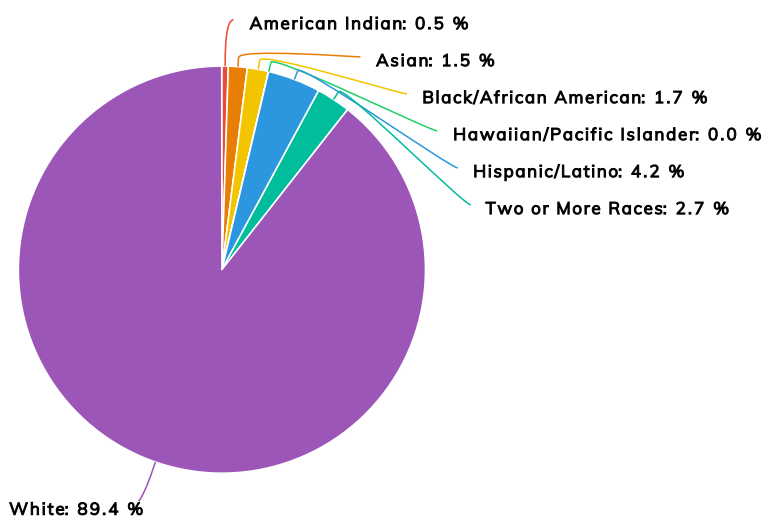

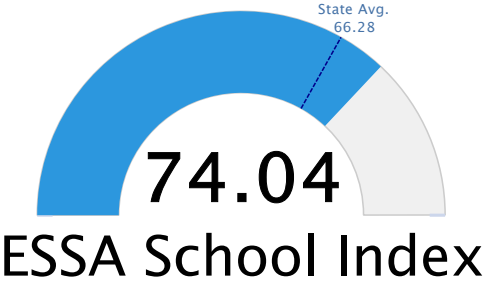
