

Lunch Delivery Program
Meals-in-Motion
March 30th through April 9, 2020
April 13th through 17, 2020

Beginning Monday, March 30, 2020, the Charleston School District will deliver no-cost meals for our students and local children under the age of 18. To promote social distancing, meals will NOT be available at the cafeteria.

Eligibility: Children 18 and under residing in the Charleston School District may receive a free hot lunch and next-day breakfast.

Sign-Up Required: To receive a delivery, parents/guardians must complete the ONLINE Lunch Delivery Program participation form and submit it to the district. The form must be received no later than 8:00 p.m. for a next day delivery. We will continue to check this form each evening to identify new participants. A one-time submission of the online form is all that is necessary for continued participation. Those who enroll initially but wish to discontinue deliveries may do so by call 479-965-7160.

The menu will consist of items such as chicken strips, crispitos, corn dogs, hamburgers, and pizza. District staff members will be making deliveries and leave meals on your front doorstep. Deliveries will begin at 11 a.m..
